AN APPEAL BY FAITH LEADERS TO MR. DIRK VAN DE PUT, CEO OF MONDELEZ INTERNATIONAL AND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS: NABISCO WORKERS DESERVE ECONOMIC JUSTICE

We are religious leaders from many faith traditions who believe that all persons have dignity and worth. The social teachings of our faith groups affirm the right of workers to associate freely in the workplace, to bargain collectively and to maintain effective unions to represent their just concerns and to enhance community life.

Mondelez International, based in Deerfield, Illinois, has operations in countries around the world, making various brands of snack foods. One of these snacks is Oreos, produced under the Nabisco Brand Name.

Since February 29, 2016, nearly 2000 Nabisco workers making Oreos and other Nabisco products who are represented by the Bakery, Confectionary, Tobacco and Grain Millers International Union (BCTGM) at baking facilities in Atlanta, GA; Chicago, IL; Fairview, NJ; Portland, OR; Denver, CO; and Richmond, VA, have been working without a new contract.

Based on the social teachings of our faith groups, we believe that Mondelez International has a moral responsibility to treat its workers with dignity and respect; especially, when business conditions fluctuate, and management seeks to cut costs through personnel adjustments.

Prior to the start of the negotiations in May of 2015, Mondelez demanded that workers in Chicago concede \$46,000,000 annually on an ongoing basis as a way to keep their jobs from being sent to your new facility in Salinas Mexico where workers are paid just over one dollar per hour. This amounted to a 60% reduction in wages and benefits. The company transferred the 600 jobs from their Chicago bakery to their new Mexican facility by mid-year 2016. In the meantime, the corporate CEO in compensation alone was averaging over twenty million dollars annually.

In the same way, we understand that your company has demanded that the workers abandon the negotiated defined benefit pension that the company has participated in for nearly 60 years in exchange for savings accounts. This too raises profound moral concerns.

We call on you to maintain the company's commitment to its longtime workforce and not suddenly change the covenants ratified over many years between BCTGM and Mondelez/Nabisco.

Furthermore, these demands for serious changes in the union contract by your company have taken place after the outsourcing of 600 jobs from the Chicago plant to Salinas, Mexico. A report issued by the IWJ (Interfaith Worker Justice) shows the emotional effects of outsourcing on the human persons whose jobs have been or could be outsourced. Moreover, research shows that the wages and benefits paid workers in Salinas continue to be just about 5% of what U.S. BCTGM bakery workers earn. Again, from a moral perspective, we as faith leaders cannot emphasize enough the unethical dimensions of this action by your company and its effect on local communities.

We call on Mondelez International to negotiate a new contract with BCTGM that maintains health care benefits and a pension plan that would provide for the retirement security of the workers. Furthermore, jobs should not be outsourced to Mexico as a way to evade the promises made by your company to its workers in the United States.

We would request the opportunity of meeting with you or your representative so that we can address our concerns to you and members of the board of directors directly.
