

How Your Dues Are Used

Your dues money supports the BCTGM programs and activities described in this booklet. Union publications and communications with members, research and bargaining assistance, advice to locals, organizing and representing members are among the activities and services you support with your dues. Dues are divided between the local union and the International Union, with most of the money used directly by the local union.

Each level of the union prepares annual financial reports. Those reports are regularly provided to Federal and Provincial authorities as required by law.



BCTGM-PAC (Political Action Committee)

Dues money is *not* contributed directly to the campaigns of candidates for federal office.

In the U.S., political contributions are made separately and voluntarily by members through BCTGM-PAC, our Political Action Committee.
